1. Team Overview

The IT Team at NIAB maintains and develops software to support the business. This is primarily web-based software but also includes some desktop applications. We look after servers, usually as Virtual Machines (VMs) and moving towards Docker and Kubernetes for software deployment.

2. Role purpose

- Maintain and develop software, for in-house and externally facing systems (on AWS, GCP) used across the business
- Contribute to the DevOps function, primarily using Docker/Kubernetes and VMs
- Automate the testing and deployment of in-house software

3. Financial authority/responsibility

Budgeting for development usage of cloud services. Efficiently using services to minimise cost.

4. Key relationships

Internal: Provide local and remote user support for software. Understand requirements, issues and guidance for non-technical colleagues using software. Work with IT colleagues and communicate effectively.

External: Advise on requirements and discuss issues with external suppliers.
