Agrochemical Applications:

- Machinery Maintenance: Ensures operational readiness of farm equipment.
- **Stock Management:** Regular stock assessments, effective communication for replenishment, and maintaining accurate records.
- Any Other Duties: As required to support the team.

6. Working conditions

- Work outdoors year-round in all weather conditions, with exposure to sunlight, rain, and varying temperatures.
- Regular work in glasshouses and polytunnels, often in high temperatures.
- Frequent exposure to plant materials, pathogens, pollen, bees, and other insects.
- Routine exposure to dust, such as soil particles from milled seeds.
